Day 1: Overnight Flight - Arrive Athens, Greece

Board your overnight flight to Europe.

Day 2: Arrive Athens, Greece

Today's highlight will surely be a visit to the **Acropolis** with its incredible **Parthenon**, one of the most recognizable monuments in the world. Entrance is included to tour the **National Archaeological Museum of Athens**. Later continue to the **Plaka**, the oldest part of the city to enjoy free time for shopping.

Day 4: Athens - Kalambaka

Today travel north to Thessaly in central Greece. Enroute stop in **Thermopylae** to admire the **Monument to King Leonidas & the 300 Spartans**, celebrating the battle of Thermopylae from 480 BC. Later enjoy a guided visit to two **Meteora Monasteries**, a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. The monasteries are built on spectacular natural sandstone rock pillars and although it is unknown when Meteora was established, hermit monks were believed to be living among the caves and cutouts in the rocks as early as the 11th century. Overnight in nearby **Kalambaka** where you will enjoy dinner at the hotel.

Day 5: Kalambaka - Delphi

This morning depart for **Delphi** which clings to the side of Mount Parnassus at 2,000 feet. Here you visit **Ancient Delphi** to see the **Sanctuary of Apollo**, the **Doric Temple and Theater**. Also visit the **Delphi Museum** before checking into your hotel.

Meal - B,D Overnight: Delphi

Day 6: Delphi - Piraeus - Board Cruise - Mykonos

Depart for Piraeus to board your **Louis Cruise Lines Ship** for a **4-night cruise**. Louis Cruise Lines is the

Day 9: Heraklion, Crete - Santorini

Maybe take an excursion to The Palace of Knossos, the largest Bronze Age archaeological site on Crete, probably the ceremonial and political center of the Minoan civilization. Later cruise to **Santorini**, Greece's most romanticized island, famous for its white-washed buildings and hilltop location overlooking the Aegean Sea.
